WHAT DOES NCADV DO?

We Work to Eliminate Domestic Violence

NCADV is devoted to the elimination of domestic violence among urban and rural families, across all racial, religious and economic groups. NCADV identifies and works to eradicate the social conditions that perpetuate or condone domestic violence such as sexism, ageism, and easy access to guns.

We Empower Victims of Domestic Violence

NCADV protects and empowers victims of domestic violence through vigilance and sponsorship of public policy initiatives and legislation such as the Violence Against Women Act. We provide free resources to victims and service providers such as *Hope and Power for Your Personal Finances: A Rebuilding Guide Following Domestic Violence* produced by The National Endowment for Financial Education and *Every Home a Safe Home* produced by Soroptomist International.

We Promote and Unify Direct Services for Victims of Domestic Violence

NCADV serves as the membership organization, the coalition builder and the technical advisor for the organizations nationwide that provide services for victims of domestic violence, such as the 2000 women's shelters across the US.

We Alert and Educate the Public

NCADV alerts the public to the facts of domestic violence such as how to recognize domestic violence and what to do about it; the signs of teen dating violence; the impact of family violence on children; and family violence against the disabled and the elderly, in addition to others.

We Promote Partnerships

NCADV partners with family and women's organizations, with the medical community, with corporations and foundations to design and fund innovative programming to eliminate domestic violence and to foster development of safe alternatives, self reliance and recovery of victims.

What Does NCADV Membership Provide?
